Mortar life



Ardurit S38 rapid hardening floor tile bedding mortar from Ardex was used to fix H & R Johnson floor tiles in the reception area of Hamerville Magazines Headquarters.

The reception area is in continuous use, which meant no time was available to remove the existing floor tiles and refurbish the exposed sub-floor. Work proceeded with the existing tiles being thoroughly cleaned and primed with Ardion 82 2-part primer prior to fixing the new floor tiles. Following this, Ardurit

S38 was mixed with water to a fluid/pourable consistency to facilitate solid bedding of the large format tiles. The rapid hardening properties of S38 enabled the floor tiles to be walked on and grouted in only 5 hours. Ardu-Flex FL flexible, rapid setting grout was chosen as it enabled the finished tiling to be walked on after a further 1½ hours.
